Freshly retired, after spending several years working with his brother to assemble their crane company into an industry leader, John had no idea that important trip would allow JLG Industries, Inc to emerge. The world leader of mobile aerial work platforms and precision material handling technologies was the end result of a road expedition.

Whilst on their trip, John spent time talking to former business contacts whom the Groves stopped to visit along the way. These conversations combined with a tragic event-two workers being electrocuted on scaffolding when the Groves were traveling to the Hoover Dam- John discovered a substantial marketplace for a product that could quickly and safely lift people in the air to accomplish upkeep and other building functions.

After returning from their vacation, John set up a business with two of his friends and purchased a metal fabricating business in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania. Starting with a small crew of twenty employees, they produced and sold their first JLG aerial work platform in 1970. The company incorporates some of the simple design elements of that original lift into current versions.

Since then, JLG Forklifts have come a great distance from when Mr. John L. Grove returned from his fatefull cross-country trip and since the first JLG aerial platform entered the market. As of today, the business has expanded itself into quite a few global markets and continues to cultivate modern equipment to guarantee that clients are able to become safer and more well-organized within their workplace.
